VENUE



Our host venue, the Broadmoor Resort, has had a long-standing commitment of cleanliness and high service standards, including deep cleaning with hospital-grade disinfectants, and evolved procedures throughout the hotel in public spaces, food and beverage services, and in meeting/event spaces. ONSITE



Attendees, vendors and staff entering the event space will be required to complete a temperature check each day of the event. You will receive a green sticker on your badge for each day you have received a temperature check coming into the room. There will be medical staff onsite at the resort as well should you have any questions or concerns.



Room drop bags will be given at check-in the first evening instead of dropped in your room for extra safety precautions. In your bag you will find a facemask, hand sanitizer, touchless door opener keychain and other goodies from our event partners. We will have additional disposable masks and gloves available upon request. Hand sanitizer stations will be set up throughout the meeting space and hotel.

We ask that everyone refrains from hugging or hand shaking as we will be practicing social distancing protocols during the event. An elbow tap will do just fine!

MASKS REQUIRED



Masks are required at every Club Solutions Leadership Summit event function. While Club Solutions will provide masks for each guest in your bag, you're welcome to bring your own to show off as well! Masks will be required through the duration of the event unless you are eating, drinking or are outside with 6 feet in between you and others.
